# **Hot Air Balloon Hats**

By: Bernat

Created with fluffy pom poms and a twisted cable design, these hats are visually striking and perfect for keeping little noggins nice and toasty.



## **Materials**

# **Baby Hat:**

- Caron International's Simply Soft (100% acrylic)
  - #9726 Soft Yellow (MC), 2 1/2
     oz/71 gr
  - #9719 Soft Pink (A), 1 oz/28.3 gr;

**Right Cross:** Slip 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k2, k2 from cn needle.

**Left Cross**: Slip 2 sts to cn and hold in front, k2, k2 from cn

**Crisscross stitch:** (multiple of 6 + 2 for selvage edges)

#### **Instructions**

Row 1: Knit.

**Row 2** and all even-numbered rows: Purl. **Row 3:** K1, \*right cross on 4 sts, k2; repeat

 gr

# Kids' Hat:

- Caron International's Simply Soft Brites (100% acrylic)
  - #9504 Limelight (MC), 3 oz/85
     gr
  - #9609 Berry Blue (A), 1
     oz/28.3 gr
  - #9604 Watermelon (B), 1
     oz/28.3 gr
- One circular needle size US 8 (5mm) needles 20" or 24" long or size to obtain gauge
- Cable needle (cn)
- Yarn needle
- Pompom maker for 1 1/2" pompoms

**Gauge:** In k2, p2 rib, 20 sts and 24 rows = 4"/10cm

In Crisscross stitch, 20 sts and 24 rows = 4"/10cm

# **Stitches Used**

K2, p2 rib

from \* across, ending with k1.

Row 5: Knit.

**Row 7**: K1, \*k2, left cross on 4 sts; repeat

from \* across, ending with k1.

Row 8: Purl

Repeat Rows 1-8 for the Crisscross pattern.

# Hats

With A, cast on 74 (86) sts. Work in k2, p2 rib for 3 rows. With B, work in k2, p2 rib for 3 rows. With MC, purl 1 row.

With MC, work in Crisscross pattern for 5" (6"), ending with pattern Row 4.

# **Shaping**

**Row 5:** \*K8, k2 tog; repeat from \*to\* across, ending with k4 (k6) -- 67 (78) sts.

Row 6: Purl.

**Row 7:** K3, \*work left cross on next 4 sts, k2tog; repeat from \* across, ending with k4 (k3) -- 57 (66) sts.

Row 8: Purl.

**Row 1:** \*K3, k2tog; repeat from \* to\* across, ending with k2 (1) -- 46 (53) sts.

Row 2: Purl.

**Row 3:** \*K2, k2tog; repeat from \* across, ending with k2 (1) -- 35 (40) sts.

Row 4: Purl.

**Row 5:** \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* across, ending with k2 (1) -- 24 (27) sts.

# For Baby only

Row 6: P2 tog across -- 12 sts. End off

leaving a long enough tail to sew back seam. Note: Hat should measure approximately. 6".

# For Kids' only

Row 6: Purl.

**Row 7**: K2 tog across, end k1 -- 14 sts. **Row 8**: Purl. End off here leaving a long enough tail to sew back seam.

Hat is approx. 7 1/2".

# **Finishing**

Sew back seam.

# **Pompoms**

Make 6 for each hat -- 2 in each of the 3 colors used. Leave about a 6-7" tail on each pompom. Pull all the tails from the 6 pompoms through the hole in top of hat and secure tightly on the inside of hat.

Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.

- Bernat® Berella '4' (100 g/3.5 oz; 197 m/216 yds) or
- Bernat® Super Value (197 g/7 oz; 389 m/426 yds)
- Main Color (MC) (Green) 185 m/202 yds (190 m/208 yds)
- Contrast A (Lilac) 65 m/71 yds (70 m/78 yds)
   BUNNY VERSION
- Bernat® Berella '4' (100 g/3.5 oz; 197 m/216 yds) or
- Bernat® Super Value (197 g/7 oz; 389 m/426 yds)
- Main Color (MC) (White) 185 m/202 yds (190 m/208 yds)
- Contrast A( Pink) 65 m/71 yds (70 m/78 yds)
   CAT VERSION
- Bernat® Berella '4' (100 g/3.5 oz; 197 m/216 yds) or
- Bernat® Super Value (197 g/7 oz; 389 m/426 yds

- Main Color (MC) (Black) 185 m/202 yds (190 m/208 yds)
- Contrast A (White) 65 m/71 yds (70 m/78 yds)

# **DINOSAUR VERSION**

- Bernat® Berella '4' (100 g/3.5 oz; 197 m/216 yds) or
- Bernat® Super Value (197 g/7 oz; 389 m/426 yds)
- Main Color (MC) (Green) 185 m/202 yds (190 m/208 yds)
- Contrast A (Green) 90 m/98 yds (95 m/105 yds)
- Contrast B (Lilac) 90 m/98 yds (95 m/105 yds)
- Knitting size 4.5 mm (U.S. 7)
- Pair of size 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) doublepointed knitting needles for Alien Version or size needed to obtain gauge.
- Pipe cleaners 10 ins [25.5 cm] long: 2 white for Alien Version and 2 pink for Bunny Version.

**Sizes:** To fit kid's head age 2/4 (6/8).

**Gauge:** 19 sts and 25 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in stocking st.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

Alt = Alternate(ing).

Approx = Approximately.

Beg = Beginning.

K = Knit.

K2 (3)tog = Knit next 2 (3) stitches together.

K3togtbl = Knit next 3 stitches together

through back loops.

P = Purl.

P2 (3)tog = Purl next 2 (3) stitches together.

Psso = Pass slipped stitch over.

Rem = Remaining.

Rep = Repeat(ing).

RS = Right side.

Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise.

St(s) = Stitch(es).

WS = Wrong side.

Yfwd = Yarn forward.

#### **Instructions:**

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

#### **HAT-MAIN SECTION**

With pair of needles and MC, cast on 51 (55) sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. K2. P1.

Rep last row of Seed St Ribbing until work from beg measures 6 (7) ins [15 (18) cm], ending with a WS row.

**Next row:** (RS). Cast on 24 (28) sts. \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. K2. P1. 75 (83) sts. Place marker at end of row.

Rep last row of Seed St Ribbing until work from marked row measures  $3\frac{3}{4}$  ( $4\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins [9.5 (11.5) cm], ending with a WS row.

**Shape top:** 1st row: K2. P2. K1. \*P3tog. (K2. P2) 3 times. K1. Rep from \* 3 times more. P3tog. (K2. P2) 0 (2) times more. K2. P1. 65 (73) sts.

**2nd row:** (K2. P2) 0 (2) times. K2. \*P1. K1. (P2. K2) 3 times. Rep from \* 3 times more. P1. K1. P2. K2. P1.

**3rd row:** \*K2. P2. K1. P1. K2. P2. K1. P3tog. Rep from \* 3 (4) times more. (K2. P2. K1. P1) 1 (0) time. K2. P1. 57 (63) sts.

**4th row:** K2. P1. \*K1. P2. K2. P1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**5th row:** \*K1. P3tog. K1. P1. K2. P2. K1. P1. Rep from \* 3 (4) times more. (K1. P3tog. K1. P1) 1 (0) time. K2. P1. 47 (53) sts.

**6th row:** K2. (P1. K1) 3 (1) time(s). P2. K2. \*(P1. K1) 3 times. P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 5 sts. (P1. K1) twice. P1.

**7th row:** (K1. P1) twice. \*K1. P3tog. (K1. P1) 3 times. Rep from \* 3 times more. K0 (1). (P3tog) 0 (1) time. (K1. P1) 0 (2) times. P1. K2tog. 39 (43) sts.

**8th row:** P1. \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to end of row. **9th row:** \*Sl1. K1. psso. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 20 (23) sts.

Break yarn leaving a long end. Draw end

through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew side seam.

#### **BUNNY VERSION**

Ears (make 2).

With pair of needles and A, cast on 19 sts. **1st row:** K1. \*Slip next st purlwise with yarn at front of work - Sl1Pwyf. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**2nd row:** Sl1Pwyf. \*K1. Sl1Pwyf. Rep from \* to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 4 ins [10 cm], ending with a 2nd row.

**Next row:** Sl1. K2tog. psso. Pat to last 3 sts. Sl1. K2tog. psso.

Work 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows twice more. 7 sts.

Next row: K3togtbl. K1. K3tog.

**Next row:** Sl1. K2tog. psso. Fasten off. Fold pipe cleaner in half and insert into Ear. Fold cast on edge in half and sew tog. Sew Ears in position.

#### **ALIEN VERSION**

Antennae (make 2).

With two double-pointed needles and A, cast on 4 sts.

**1st row:** \*K4. Do not turn. Slide sts to opposite end of needle. Rep from \* until work from beg measures 8 ins [20.5 cm]. Insert pipe cleaner into I-cord. Break yarn. Thread yarn through all sts. Pull tightly. Fasten securely.

**Pom-pom:** (make 4). Wind A around 3 fingers approx 60 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape. Attach pom-pom to each end of antennae. Fold antennae as shown in picture. Sew antennae in position.

# CAT VERSION

Ears (make 2).

With pair of needles and A, cast on 23 sts. **1st row:** K1. \*Slip next st purlwise with yarn at front of work - Sl1Pwyf. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**2nd row:** Sl1Pwyf. \*K1. Sl1Pwyf. Rep from \* to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

**Next row:** Sl1. K2tog. psso. Pat to last 3 sts.

Sl1. K2tog. psso. Work 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows 3 times more. 7 sts. **Next row:** K3togtbl. K1. K3tog. **Next row:** Sl1. K2tog. psso. Fasten off.

Sew Cat Ears in position.

#### **DINOSAUR VERSION**

Spike Strip (make 2): With A, cast on 3 sts. \*\*1st row: (WS). With A, K1. yfwd. K2. 4 sts.

**2nd and alt rows:** Knit. **3rd row:** K1. yfwd. K3. 5 sts. **5th row:** K1. yfwd. K4. 6 sts. **7th row:** K1. yfwd. K5. 7 sts.

9th row: K1. yfwd. K6. 8 sts. 11th row: K1. yfwd. K7. 9 sts. 13th row: K1. yfwd. K8. 10 sts. 15th row: K1. yfwd. K9. 11 sts. 17th row: K1. yfwd. K10. 12 sts. 19th row: K1. yfwd. K11. 13 sts. 21st row: K1. yfwd. K12. 14 sts.

**22nd row**: Cast off 11 sts. K3 (including st left

on needle after cast off ). 3 sts. With B, rep last 22 rows once.\*\*

Rep from \*\* to \*\* until Spike Strip measures to fit length from front edge to bottom of back

Hat-Main Section.

Sew Spikes along Hat-Main Section from front edge to bottom of back Hat-Main Section.

# **Pumpkin Pixie Hat**

By: Bernat

Dress up your little one for autumn using this festive Pumpkin Pixie Hat! This adorable hat is perfect for working on while you're on the go.



**SIZES**Infant (Toddler, Child)

## **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Circumference: 16 (18 1/4, 20)" **Note:** Hat will stretch up to 2" in circumference.

### **MATERIALS**

- Stitch.Rock.Love. Sheep(ish) from Caron (70% Acrylic/30% Wool; 3oz/85g, 167yds/153m)
  - o #0014 Coral(ish) (A): 1 skein
  - o #0020 Chartreuse(is) (B): 1 skein
- One size U.S. 8 (5mm) circular needle, 16"/40.5cm long

- One set of five size U.S. 8 (5mm) double-pointed needles (dpns)
- Stitch marker
- Yarn needle

#### **GAUGE**

In Stockinette stitch, 18 sts and 24 rows = 4"/10cm

#### **STITCHES USED**

Garter Stitch: Knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd when working in the rnd; knit all rows when working back and forth.

# **SPECIAL TECHNIQUE**

I-cord: Using a double-pointed needle, cast on the number of sts indicated in instructions; DO NOT TURN. \*Slide sts to the opposite end of the needle and knit them, pulling yarn firmly behind sts; rep from \* to desired length. After a few rows, you will see that you are knitting a tiny tube; give it a <u>gentle</u> tug now and then to adjust any loose sts. Bind off all sts, leaving a 2"/5cm tail for finishing.

#### **STRIPE PATTERN**

Working in St st (knit every rnd), [work 4 rnds B, 2 rnds A] twice, \*work 2 rnds B, 2 rnds A; rep from \* for Stripe Pattern.

#### HAT

With circ needle and A, CO 72 (82, 90) sts. Join to work in the rnd, taking care not to twist sts; place marker at beginning of rnd.

Work in Garter st for 6 rnds.

Change to St st and Stripe Pattern; work even for 19 (19, 23) rnds.

Shape Crown

**Note:** Change to dpns when necessary for number of sts on needle.

**Dec Rnd 1:** Continuing in Stripe Pattern, \*k2tog, k4; rep from \* to last 6 (4, 6) sts, k2tog, k4 (2, 4)–60 (68, 75) sts. Knit 2 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 2**: \*K3, k2tog; rep from \* to last 0 (3, 0) sts, k0 (3, 0)-48 (55, 60) sts. Knit 1 rnd. **Dec Rnd 3**: \*K2tog, k2; rep from \* to last 0 (3, 0) sts, k0 (3, 0)-36 (41, 45) sts. Knit 1 rnd. **Dec Rnd 4**: \*K2tog, k1; rep from \* to last 0 (2, 0) sts, k0 (2, 0)-24 (28, 30) sts. Knit 1 rnd. **Dec Rnd 5**: \*K2tog; rep from \* to end-12 (14, 15) sts. Discontinuing Stripe Pattern and continuing in B, knit 3 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 6:** \*K2tog; rep from \* to last 0 (0, 1) st(s), k0 (0, 1)-6 (7, 8) sts. Knit 3 rnds.

Change to A; knit 3 rnds.

Break yarn, weave through remaining sts, cinch shut on WS.

# EARFLAPS (make 2)

Fold Hat in half widthwise, with beginning of

rnd at fold line. Mark center of each side of Hat for center of Earflap. With RS facing, dpns and A, pick up and knit 5 sts on either side of one center marker–10 sts. Knit 5 rows.

**Dec Row**: Ssk, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog-8 sts. Knit 3 rows.

Rep Dec Row every other row 3 times–2 sts. Continuing with remaining sts, make a 11"/28cm length of I-cord. BO all sts. Trim tail.

# **FINISHING**

Using yarn needle, weave in ends.

# **For Adults**

# **Day Dream Hat**

By: Julie Farmer from Red Heart Yarn

Create a hat using the colors of the sunset with this simple design. Featuring a ribbed border and stockinette stitch body, this cozy hat is just the thing you'll need to keep warm all winter long.



Hat measures 21" in circumference.

#### **Materials:**

- RED HEART® Boutique™ Unforgettable™: 1 ball of 3955 Winery.
- **Circular Knitting Needles**: 4.5mm [US 7] and 5 mm [US 8] 16"
- **Double Pointed Knitting Needles:** 5 mm [US 8].
- Marker, Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 18 sts = 4"; 24 rows = 4" in with larger needle in Stockinette Stitch.

**Note :** Change to double pointed needles when there are too few stitches for the circular needle.

#### **HAT**

# Ribbing

With smaller needles, cast on 100 sts. Join, being careful

that sts are not twisted, and begin working in the round.

Place marker for beginning of round.

**Round 1 (Right side):** (K2, P2) around. Repeat Round 1 for pattern until piece measures approximately 2" from cast on edge.

# Body

With larger needle, knit around until piece measures approximately 7" from cast on edge.

# **Crown Shaping**

Round 1: (K8, k2tog) around: 90 sts.

Round 2: Knit around.

Round 3: (K7, k2tog) around: 80 sts.

Round 4: Knit around.

Round 5: (K6, k2tog) around: 70 sts.

**Round 6:** Knit around.

Round 7: (K5, k2tog) around: 60 sts.

**Round 8:** Knit around.

Round 9: (K4, k2tog) around: 50 sts.

**Round 10:** Knit around.

**Round 11:** (K3, k2tog) around: 40 sts.

Round 12: (K2, k2tog) around: 30 sts.

**Round 13:** (K1, k2tog) around: 20 sts.

Round 14: K2tog around: 10 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" end. Thread yarn needle with end

and weave through remaining stitches. Draw

up firm;

fasten securely.

#### ABBREVIATIONS:

**mm** = millimeter

 $\mathbf{P} = \mathbf{purl}$ 

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

# **Easy Fit Ribbed Hat**

By: Mary Jane Protus for Red Heart Yarn

If you're new to knitting or have never knitted a hat before, this simple pattern from Red Heart is just what you need. Cute knitted hats like this make great gifts for everyone and are easy and fun to make! Embellish it with a flower or pom for extra flair!



# **Materials:**

- Red Heart® With Love™: 1 skein 1252
   Mango
- Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10]
- Yarn needle

# **Instructions:**

Hat measures 18 inches around (slightly stretched).

**GAUGE:** 16 sts = 4"; 20 rows = 4" in ribbing, slightly stretched. Use any size needles to

obtain the gauge.

#### Hat

Cast on 70 sts.

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** \*Purl 2, knit 2; repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, purl 2.

**Row 2 (Right Side):** \*Knit 2, purl 2; repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, knit 2.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until work measures 10 inches from beginning, ending with a wrong side row.

# **Shape Crown**

**Row 1 (Right Side):** \*Knit 2, purl 2 together (decrease 1 stitch); repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, knit 2 – 53 stitches.

**Row 2 (Wrong Side):** \*Purl 2, knit 1; repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, purl 2.

**Row 3:** \*Knit 2, purl 1; repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, knit 2.

Row 4: Repeat Row 2.

**Next Row:** \*Knit 2 together, purl 1; repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, knit 2 – 36 stitches. **Next Row:** Purl 2, \*knit 1, purl 1; repeat from \* to end.

**Next Row:** \*Knit 2 together; repeat from \* to end – 18 stitches.

Next Row: Purl.

**Last Row:** \*Knit 2 together; repeat from \* to end – 9 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long end for seaming.

Weave yarn through remaining stitches; gather stitches up firmly and secure. Sew the back seam. Starting about 3 inches from the bottom, sew the seam on the reverse side, as this will be turned up for the brim.

#### Shaker Rib Hat + Scarf

By: Bernat

This classic scarf-and-hat set is perfect for keeping away the winter chill. And they're so easy to make, you'll be knitting the entire family their own set for the holidays!



#### Size:

**Scarf:** Approx 7 x 58 ins [18 x 147.5 cm]. **Hat:** One size to fit average lady.

## **MATERIALS**

- Bernat® Super Value (Solids 7 oz / 197 g) (350 m / 382 yds) or (Ombres 5 oz / 142g) (251 m / 275 yds) (53221 Soft Fern) or (53116 Faded Denim) or (53044 True Grey) or (28813 Techno Ombre)
- Hat: 1 ball, Scarf: 1 ball OR Bernat® Berella 4 (Solids 100 g/3.5 oz) (197 m/216 yds)
- Hat: 1 ball, Scarf: 2 balls or Bernat® Berella 4 (Ombres 85 g / 3 oz) (150 m / 165 yds)

Hat: 1 ball, Scarf: 3 balls OR Bernat®
 Satin (Solids 100 g / 3.5 oz) (149 m / 163 yds) or (Ombres 80 g / 2.8 oz) (119 m / 130 yds)

**Hat: 1 ball, Scarf: 3 balls** Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 

**GAUGE:** 18 sts and 24 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in stocking st.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

**K1below** = Knit into next stitch 1 row below at same time slipping off stitch above (see diagram).

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

**HAT:** Cast on 83 sts. **1st row:** (WS). Knit.

2nd row: K1. \*K1below. P1. Rep from \* to last

2 sts.

K1below. K1.

Rep last 2 rows of Rib Pat for  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ins [14 cm], ending with a

RS row.

**Shape top: Next row:** K1. \*Sl1. K2tog. psso.

K3. Rep from

\* to last 4 sts. Sl1. K2tog. psso. K1. 55 sts.

**Note:** When working K1below after a dec row, be sure to

insert the right-handed needle into all loops of dec worked in the

previous row.

**Next row:** K1. \*K1below. P1. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K1below. K1.

Next row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 6½ ins [16.5 cm],

ending with a RS row.

**Next row:** K1. \*Sl1. K2tog. psso. K1. Rep from \* to last 2 sts.

K2. 29 sts.

**Next row:** K1. P1. \*K1below. P1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**Next row:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.

**Next row:** (RS). \*K2tog. Rep from \* to last st.

K1. 15 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew center back seam.

# **SCARF**

Cast on 31 sts.

1st row: (WS). Knit.

2nd row: K1. \*K1below. P1. Rep from \* to last

2 sts.

K1below. K1.

Rep last 2 rows of Rib Pat for 60 ins [152.5

# **One Seam Guinea Pig Hat**

Don't know how to master knitting in the round with double pointed needles? Don't worry! This One Seam Guinea Pig Hat is an easy knit hat for beginners that can be made with straight knitting needles. With just one seam and not many ends to weave in, you can knit your little cavy his or her own hat in a matter of minutes with this guinea pig craft pattern. This tiny hat is perfect for knitted bears or dolls too.



### **Instructions:**

Co 32

**R 1-3**: \*K1, P1; rep from \* to end of row.

R 4: K

**R 5:** P

**R 6**: K

**R** 7: P

**R 8**: K

**R 9**: P

**R 10**: K2tog, \*K; rep from \* to end of row

**R 11**: P2tog, \*P; rep from \* to end of row

R 12: K2tog, \*K; rep from \* to end of row

**R 13**: P2tog 2x's, \*P; rep from \* to end of row

**R 14**: K2tog 2x's, \*K; rep from \* to end of row

**R 15**: P2tog 3x's, \*P; rep from \* to end of row

**R 16**: K2tog 4x's, \*K; rep from \* to end of row

**R 17**: P2tog 5x's, \*P; rep from \* to end of row

**R 18**: K2tog 3x's, \*K; rep from \* to end of row

**R 19**: P2tog 2x's, \*P; rep from \* to end of row

R 20: K2tog 2x's, \*K; rep from \* to end of row

# Finishing:

Cut yarn and pull tightly through remaining stitches. Seam up the side of the hat and weave in ends. If desired, attach a small white pom pon to the top of the hat.

# **Materials:**

- U.S. size 7 knitting needles
- Red Heart Super Saver Yarn in Cherry Red
- White scrap yarn, worsted weight
