The Rubies and Diamonds Hat

Knitting Needle Size: 10 or 6 mm, Circular Knitting Needles, Double-Pointed Knitting Needles (DPNs)

Yarn Weight: (5) Bulky/Chunky

Materials

- US 10 Circular Knitting Needles
- Double-Pointed Knitting Needles (DPNs)
- Bulky yarn (5) | Loops & Threads Woolike Chunky Yarn
- Stitch marker



Pattern

Ribbing and Motif

CO 60 sts + 1 for the <u>invisible join</u>

Rnds 1-7: (K2, p2), repeat () all the way round

Rnds 8-10: K all sts

Rnds 11-37: Follow the pattern in the chart below

Shaping

Move sts to your DPNs evenly (15 sts per needle)

Rnd 38: K4, (cdd, k7), repeat () until you have 3 sts

remaining in the row, k3

Note: See below for how to work a "cdd" or centered double

decrease.

Rnds 39 and 40: K all sts

Rnd 41: K3, (cdd, k5), repeat () until you have 2 sts

remaining in the row, k2

Rnd 42: K all sts

Rnd 43: K2, (cdd, k3), repeat () until you have 1 st remaining

in the row, k1

Rnd 44: K all sts

Rnds 45-48: Continue in St st, placing cdds in line with the 6 columns of decreasing below until you've finished the hat.

Weave in ends.

How to Work a Centered Double Decrease:

- 1. Slip two stitches together knitwise
- 2. Knit 1
- 3. Pass both of the slipped stitches over the knitted stitch
